BRIDGES – INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION AUGUST 16-17

Bridges is a two-day orientation specially designed for international students starting an academic program who are new to the University of Dayton. Bridges is your first and most important introduction to the university and the U.S. Attendance is required.
