The first step to Transfer Student Orientation (TSO) is registering. Log into Porches at go.udayton.edu/admission to register for the 2016 Transfer Program. Registration will close on August 19. Access the transfer orientation schedule, general orientation academic events and socials, maps, UD information and much more through our New Student Programs app on your smartphone!
