UNION ADVISORY BOARD (UAB)
CONSTITUTION

Purpose

The University of Dayton Union Advisory Board (hereafter referred to as the “Advisory Board” or “UAB”) shall make recommendations for policies and practices for Kennedy Union. The decisions and recommendations of the Advisory Board are subject to review and acceptance by the Executive Director of the Center for Student Involvement.

Opportunities

Members of the Advisory Board have the opportunity to serve the campus community by making recommendations for policy, operations, and programming regarding Kennedy Union and the Center for Student Involvement. The Advisory Board gives students and others the opportunity to shape, develop, and implement changes that contribute to the community center of campus. Through participation in the advisory board, students, faculty, and staff engage in meaningful dialogue, particularly allowing the student members to establish, maintain, and strengthen relationships with university faculty, staff, and administration.

Membership

The Advisory Board shall be constituted as follows:

4 Undergraduate students (not representing any organization/category)

1 Undergraduate Commuter Student

1 Graduate student

2 Student employees of the Center for Student Involvement

1 KU Dining Services Staff Member (appointed by the Director of Dining Services)

9 Students representing each of the following:

1 – Student Government Association

1 – Campus Activities Board

1 – Academic Student Organization

1 – Recreation Student Organization

1 – Media Student Organization

1 – Special Interest Student Organization

1 – Values-Based Greek Student Organization

1 – Faith-Based/Religious Student Organization

1 – Service and Social Action Student Organization

2 Faculty/Staff Advisers to Student Organizations

2 Faculty

2 Staff

24 + Chair = 25 Individuals

Applications will be made available each November and appointments will be confirmed for the following calendar year (spring and fall semesters) by December 1.

Terms of Appointment

Student members shall serve a minimum of a one-year term, with the possibility to renew for a second year.

Faculty/staff members shall serve a minimum of one two-year term with the possibility to renew for a second two-year term.

The Advisory Board will be chaired by the Executive Director of the Center for Student Involvement.

Eligibility

Student members shall have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 upon appointment to the Advisory Board and must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 during their term of appointment. They must also be in good standing with the University.

Meetings

The Advisory Board shall meet twice a semester in the fall and spring. The specific day and time for meetings will be established by the Executive Director of the Center for Student Involvement. The meetings shall be scheduled so as to accommodate as many members as possible.
