

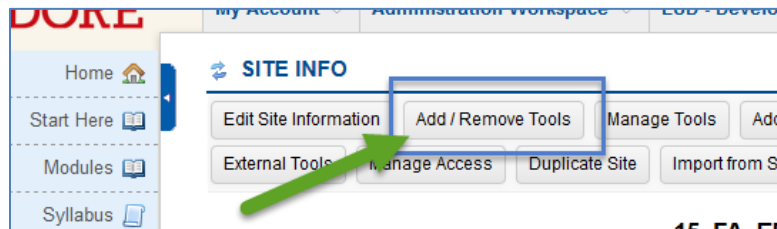
Adding a link to the Student Success Network to your Isidore site

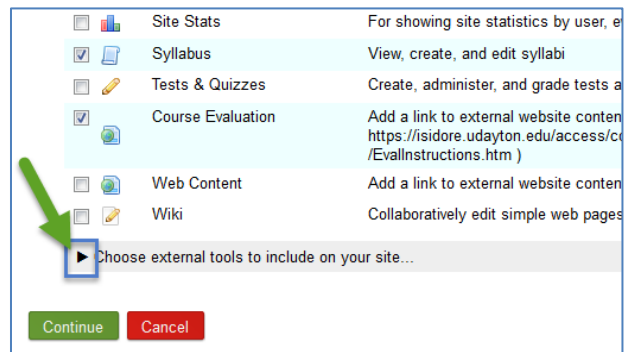

Task 1 - Adding the Student Success Network tool to your Isidore site

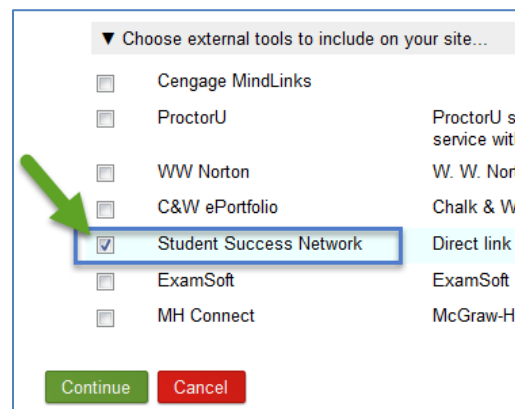
1. Log in to your Isidore course.
2. Click on the **Site Info** tool in the left-hand menubar.
3. Click on the **Add/Remove Tools** button at the top of the Site Info tool page.



4. Scroll to the bottom of the tool list on the next page and click on the black arrow next to 'Choose external tools to include on your site....' as shown on the right.



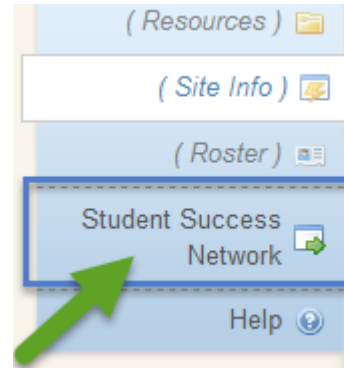
5. Next, check the box next to **Student Success Network** from the expanded list and click the **Continue** button.



- Click the **Continue** button on the next page and the **Finish** button on the following page to complete the process.

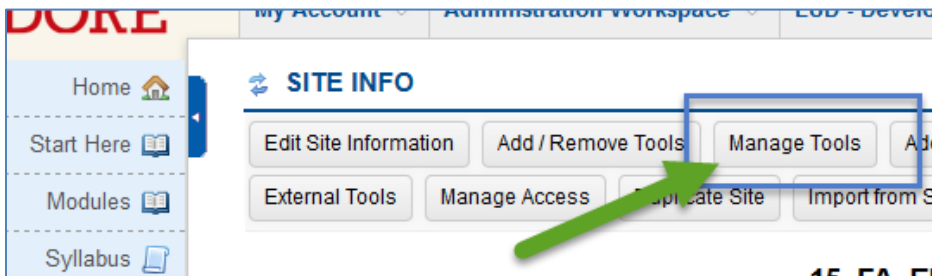
You should now see the **Student Success Network** tool listed in your left-hand menubar.

Please move on to Task 2 for directions on how to hide the tool from student view.

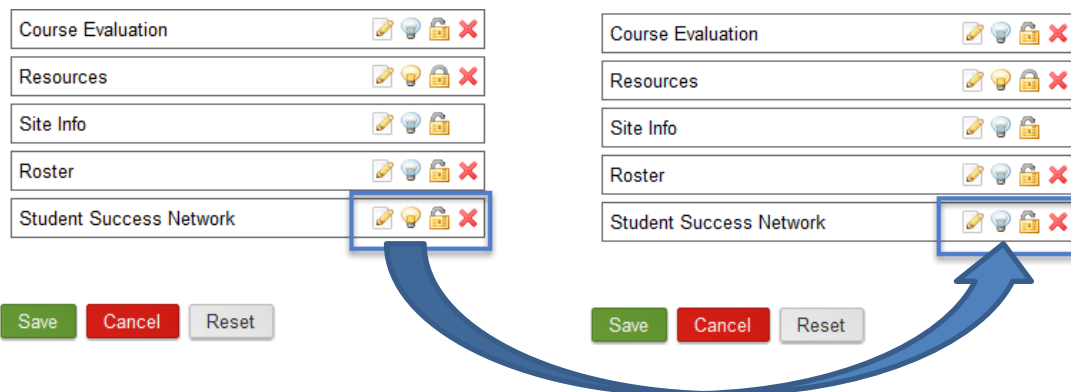


Task 2 - Hiding the Student Success Network tool from students

- Click on the **Manage Tools** button at the top of the Site Info tool.

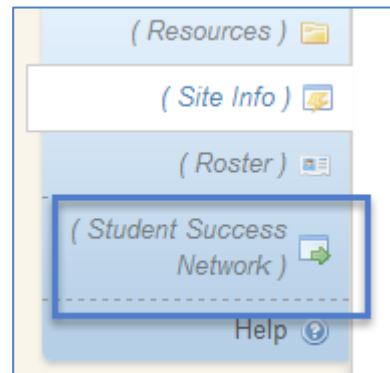


- Click the light bulb icon next to the 'Student Success Network' item as shown below. The light bulb will be yellow when you first view it (indicating that students can see the tool) but it should turn white/blue once you've clicked on it (indicating that the tool is hidden from students).



3. Click the **Save** button after you've turned the light bulb off to complete the process.

You should now see the **Student Success Network** tool listed in your left-hand menubar in parenthesis and italics. This lets you know that the tool is hidden from students.
