

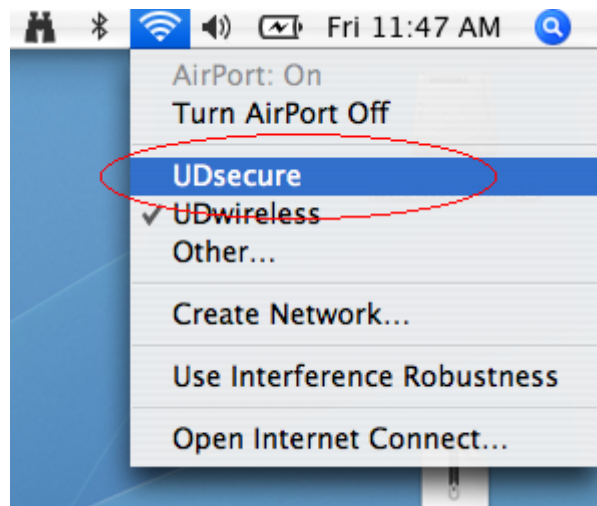
Connecting to UDsecure with a Mac

Follow these steps to connect your Mac to the University of Dayton's secure wireless network.

1. Click on the AirPort Settings in the top right of your screen.



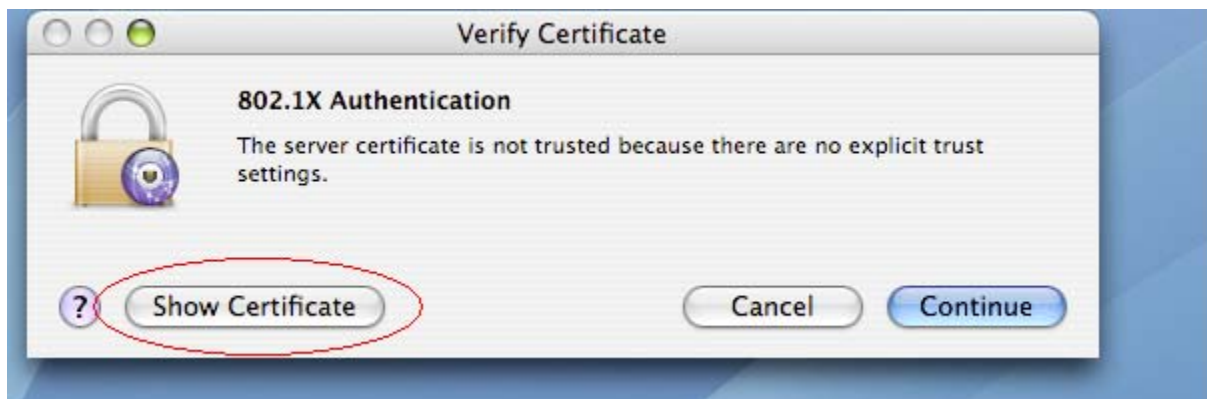
2. Select "UDsecure" from the drop down menu



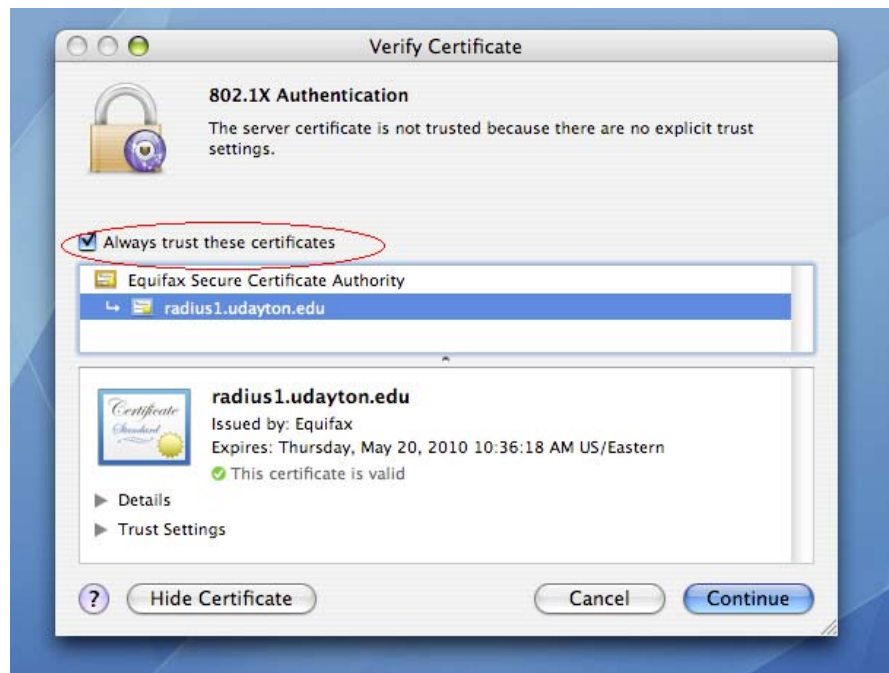
3. Enter your LDAP/Novell username and password and click OK.



4. Now it will prompt you to verify the certificate. Click on "Show Certificate". **You will only have to do this ONCE.**



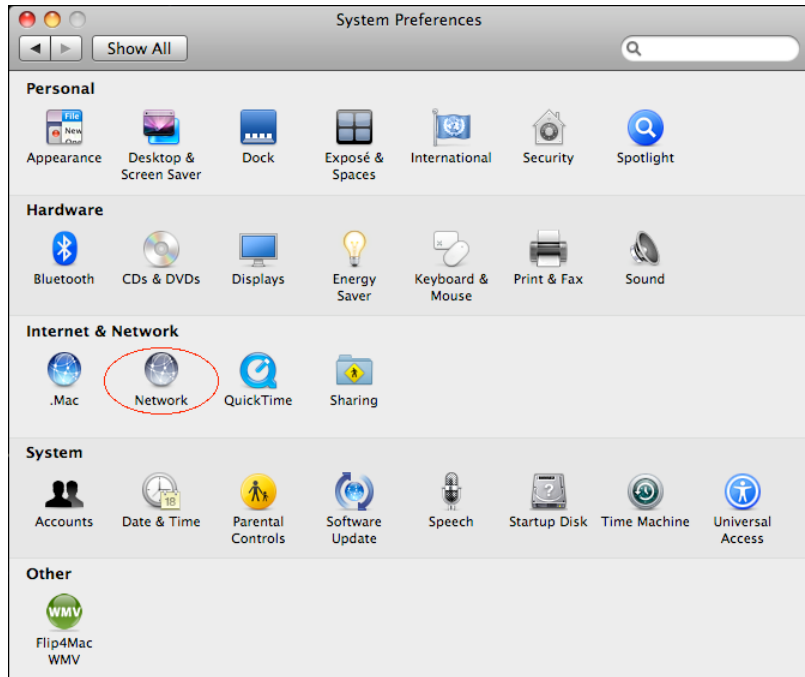
5. Check the box marked “Always trust these certificates.” Make sure the certificate is from **radius1.udayton.edu** and hit continue.



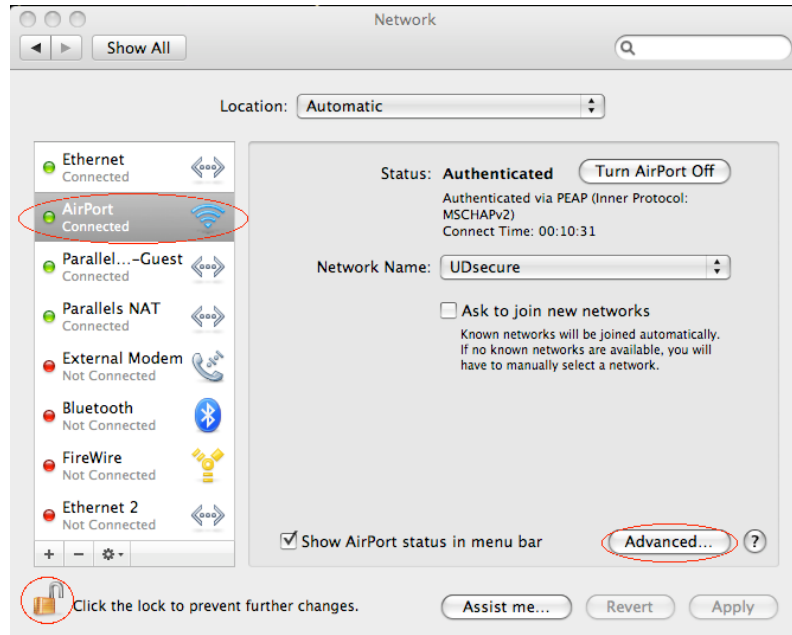
At this point you should be connected to UDsecure.

Making UDsecure your Preferred Connection

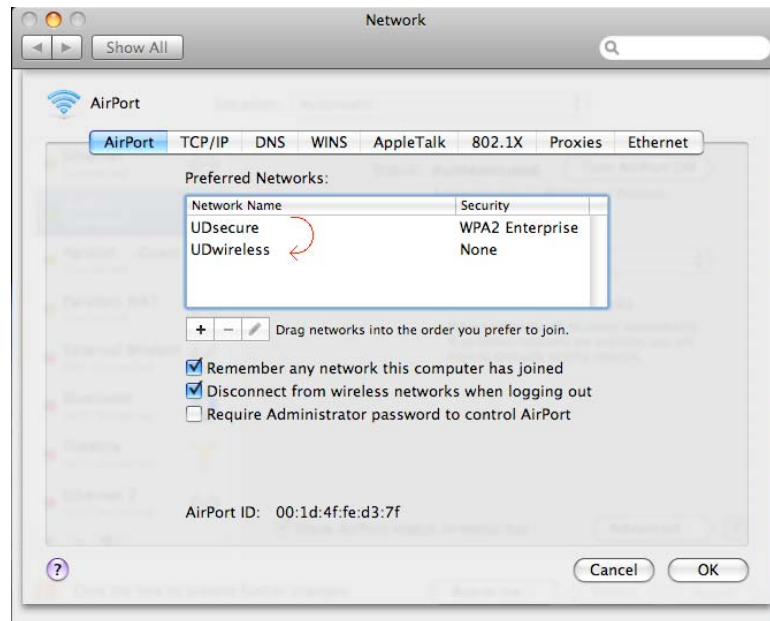
1. In the Apple menu, select “System Preferences”, and click the “Network” icon.



2. If necessary, click the Lock icon to unlock these preferences, click on AirPort in the left panel to highlight it, and then click the “Advanced” button



3. On the AirPort tab, drag “UDwireless” below “UDsecure” (if “UDsecure” isn't at the top). This will cause the Mac to connect to “UDsecure” when available and “UDwireless” otherwise. Click the “OK” button when finished.



4. Click the “Apply” button (and the “Lock” icon if you keep System Preferences locked). Then close the System Preferences (or “Network”) window.
