



OOPS! You clicked on a phishing email.

Think about these questions to strengthen your phish detection skills:

- Is the email expected?
- Is the sender's address legit?
For example: @MSoffice365.com is not the same as @office365.com or a Microsoft domain
- On hover, do I recognize where the link points?
For example, <http://singlesignon.secured-login.net/?>



Do this instead:

- Be wary of logging into sites that are not https://
- Don't click on a link you don't recognize
- Visit your account by manually typing in the valid URL
- When in doubt, delete suspicious emails or, if you have questions or concerns, contact:
