

Isidore Tip – Viewing More Sites

Are you wondering why there aren't tabs for some of your Isidore courses? This tip will explain how to find your other courses.

Once you're enrolled in four or more Isidore courses, a drop-down menu appears that says "More Sites." You need to click on the drop-down menu to select other courses you want to visit.
