


Isidore Tip – The Student and TA Views

What do your students or TAs see when they log into your site? Use the ‘View Site As’ function and find out for yourself!

What is the ‘View Site As’ function?

The ‘View Site As’ function allows instructors to view their course site(s) as a student would without having separate accounts to maintain. Instructors can submit assignments, take tests and quizzes, and participate in discussion forums or chats. By viewing the course as a student or TA, the instructor is able to ensure that they have properly released course materials, assignments, and assessments to students without waiting for the first complaint from their class.

To use the ‘View Site As’ function, open your Isidore course. In the upper right-hand area of the screen, click on the drop down box that says ‘Select Role’ and click on ‘Student’ or ‘Teaching Assistant.’ You can then navigate around your site as a student or TA would. To return to your instructor view, click on the link that says ‘Exit Student View.’
