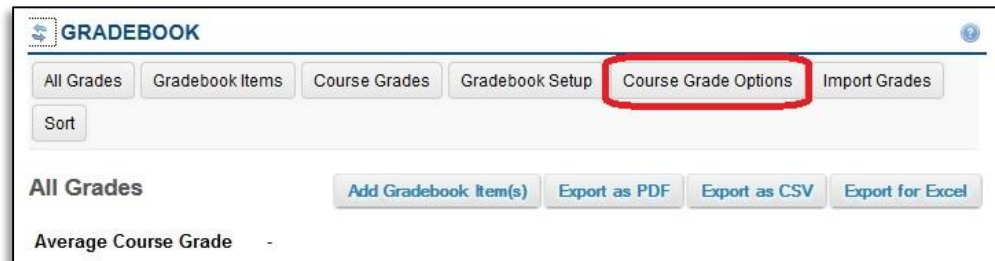



## Setting Custom Grade Scales in the Isidore Gradebook

1. Navigate to your course's Gradebook tool in Isidore.
2. Click on the "Course Grade Options" button in the menu bar at the top of the screen.



3. Select a "Grade Type" from the drop-down menu (usually UD Graduate). Click on the "Change grade type" button.
