

Recommendations for Taking Online Assessments through Isidore

Although test and quiz problems are few and far between, they occasionally do happen. Here are some general recommendations for taking online tests and quizzes in Isidore. If you experience any problem when taking an online test or quiz, please notify your instructor immediately.



Make sure that you're connected to a stable wireless or hard-wired connection. A hard-wired network connection will be more stable than a wireless network connection.



Do not open Isidore in more than one browser tab or browser window.



Do not leave the test or quiz once you've started.



Utilize the "Save" button at the bottom of your test or quiz.



Do not use your browser's forward or back buttons to navigate through the assessment. Use the "Next" and "Previous" buttons within Isidore to navigate through your assessment.



If you're taking a timed assessment, make sure that you check Isidore's server clock at the bottom of the page to make sure your computer's time isn't different. Your test will be submitted when the due date and time hits according to Isidore's clock.
