

Updated Settings Layout in Tests & Quizzes

New Organization

All of the same settings are available but they've now been divided up into five categories:



- **About section** – give your assessment a title and provide students with instructions. The instructions will be displayed before students begin the assessment.
- **Availability & Submissions section** – select the days and times the assessment will be available to students and which student(s) the assessment is released to. You can also set a time limit and control the number of submissions allowed. Finally, you can choose how late submissions are handled.
- **Grading & Feedback section** – adjust grading and feedback settings.
- **Layout section** – control how students navigate through the assessment, the number of questions on each page, and how your assessment is organized and numbered.
- **Publish section** – release the assessment to students.
