

How to get started with Snag It

Snag It is a computer screen recording software that every faculty member should have in their tool box. Snag It allows faculty to capture their lectures, during which they can choose to record their screen or their web cam. They can even take still picture shots. The new version of SnagIt allows you to edit the video and trim unwanted portions of the video.

This page will explain where to get the software and how to activate it.

I. How to Download and Install a Free Trial

To download a free 15 day trial of Snag It, please navigate your web browser to <http://www.techsmith.com/download/snagit/>. Enter your email address, select your operating system (Windows or Mac), and click on the “Download Trial” button.

Once the installer downloads, double click on it to run it. Follow the steps to install the program onto your computer.

II. How to Activate Snag It Permanently

If you’re approaching the end of your free trial, and would like to continue using Snag It for your class, please email the E-Learning Lab at elearning@udayton.edu for a permanent license code.

Once you’ve obtained a license code from the E-Learning Lab, you’ll want to launch Snag It so you can activate it. Click on the “Unlock” button, enter the license code, and click on the “OK” button. If you wish, click on the “Register” button and complete the registration information. Your copy of Snag It is ready to use.
